IMPORTANT NOTICE

The Parking Lots directly across the Street from Felix's, The Blue Crab and Landry's will have coned off Parking Spots for the staff of each Restaurant on the Lakefront. Please do NOT PARK in these spots!

Parking on Lakeshore Drive

- As athletes approach The Blue Crab Restaurant and Lakeshore Drive on West End Blvd., parking Lots 1, 2 and 3 will be the first lots runners will come in contact with heading east on Lakeshore Drive.
- Lakeshore Drive has hundreds of individual parking spots heading east that will be open on race morning. Runners are encouraged to take those spots along Lakeshore Drive on the southside ONLY!
- Athletes parking on southside of Lakeshore Drive will have to to head east upon leaving the event when your race is over. Traffic will only be allowed to flow in an easterly direction.
- Athletes are discouraged from parking on the northside of Lakeshore Drive. Inbound runners heading to the finish line will be running in the northern lanes heading west towards the finish line and the Blue Crab.
- The distance from the Blue Crab Restaurant to Parking Lot 1 and Shelter 1 is ¼ of a Mile.
- The distance from the Blue Crab Restaurant to Parking Area #2 is .6 of a Mile
- The distance from the Blue Crab Restaurant to Parking area #3 is .8 of a Mile
- The distance from the Blue Crab Restaurant to Parking Area #4 is 1.4 Miles
- The distance from the Blue Crab Restaurant to Parking area #5 is 1.7 Miles
- On event morning from 6:00am to 7:15am, Race Management will be running one shuttle bus from Shelter #1 near the starting line to the western side of the Bayou St. John Bridge to pick up and drop off athletes at Shelter #1. Shelter one is less then a ¼ mile from the Blue Crab.
- This will continue at 9:30am to assist with runners leaving the race site and heading back to some of the parking areas along Lakeshore Drive. This post event service will run from Shelter #1 to the Bayou St. John Bridge.
